**CASTED-NP** is presented by **Dr. Arun Sayal**, an emergency physician who also runs a weekly Minor Fracture Clinic at North York General Hospital in Toronto. He has presented over 100 orthopedic workshops and lectures across the country and has received over a dozen teaching awards.

- proper immobilization, moulding and positioning
- ED fracture and dislocation reduction techniques
- appropriate use of removable splints


